### Courses Offered:

1. Trot-pole Course (does not qualify for 2-Phase High Point)
2. 18" Cross-pole Course (8 jumps) (lead-line allowed)
3. 18"-2' Cross-poles and Verticals (10 jumps; 2 in combination)
4. 2'-2'3" Verticals and Oxers (10 jumps; 2 in combination)
5. 2'3"-2'6" Verticals and Oxers (10 jumps; 2 in combination)
6. 2'6"-2'9" Verticals and Oxers (10 jumps, 2 in combination)

\*There will be a maximum time allowed for each course.

### Rules:

- All courses to be ridden in ordinary snaffles
- Boots, martingales and flashes allowed
- Riders must wear helmets and boots
- Vests / body protectors allowed
- Only two consecutive levels can be ridden on one horse
- To qualify for Jumper Equitation Series High Point, competitor & horse must enter 3 of the 4 schooling shows (best 2 scores used in calculation)
- To qualify for 2-Phase High Point, competitor & horses must enter for 3 of the 4 schooling shows offered in each discipline. Please reference Dressage Schooling Show Entry form.

Courses for Jumper Equitation classes are designed to test the rider's position, security and control of the horse. It is the rider not the horse that is being judged in an equitation class, although a well-schooled, obedient horse will help the rider perform more accurately. Equitation courses usually include some tight turns and more than one change of direction. The more advanced classes may also include trotting the approach to a jump, a halt transition, or a rein back. Tests such as these, incorporated in the course, allow the riders to further demonstrate their riding ability and their horse's obedience to the aids. The jumps on an equitation course may be natural, hunter-type fences or colourful jumper-type or a combination of both. (Equine Canada, English Rider Handbook, Levels 7-8, 1998, p 90)

**Cost:** \$30.00 per single course entry. \$50 per two course entry.

All riders must ride each course twice, with a judge's critique between rounds.

Final score will be determined by the highest combined percentage.

**Rosettes for 1<sup>st</sup> place; ribbons for 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Series end high point awards.**

(You must attend three of four shows to be eligible for a high point series awards.)

Entries close the Tuesday before each show.
